Parent Workshop – How to Help Your Daughter with Revision

I am writing to give you information about a workshop event that we will be providing for parents of all year groups. This will give parents advice and guidance about revising for exams with a particular focus on GCSE examinations. For Years 7, 8 and 9 this will focus upon Test Week which takes place in July near the end of the school year. For Years 10 and 11 this will focus upon the mock examinations that take place in January and on preparing for the real GCSE exams next summer.
