Information for Students

Expectations

This is an opportunity for you to develop and consolidate learning with face-to-face teaching with your subject teachers. Dress Code

Arrival

You must arrive on time for the sessions you are attending. Parents will be contacted if you are late or absent. Upon arrival you must make your way to the room allocated to your class on the timetable and sit where you are asked to by your subject teacher, unless you are in the new Crescent Building.

If your session takes place in The Crescent Building – you will need to line up at the main gate of the Crescent Building – this is past the Dr. Khan Building (previously known as The Deepdale Mill Building). You will be met by staff who will take you to the appropriate place before being escorted into the new building. If you arrive early you will need to wait outside so please arrive on time.
