Dear Parents and Carers

Assalaamu Alaikum, I hope and pray this letter finds you in the best of health and Imaan.

On Monday evening, as part of a national lockdown, the Prime Minister announced that schools will remain closed until February half-term.

Schooling till February Half-Term

All pupils will have lessons online till February half-term.

- The children of key workers and vulnerable pupils will be able to attend school. Please let us know by emailing on info@pmghs.com if you need your child to attend school.
- Pupils will follow their usual timetable including Form time from home (online via MS Teams).
- Please ensure that your child logs on punctually for all lessons (including registration and assembly). Attendance will be monitored closely by their Heads of Year. Persistent absentees will be classed as vulnerable and may be required to attend school for their remote learning.

The Prime Minister also announced that 'it is not fair for all exams to go ahead this summer'. However, we are waiting for more information on this. As soon as we have more details, we will share it with parents and pupils. In the meantime, students in all exam classes should continue attending lessons online as normal. The postponed mock examinations have now been scheduled to take place upon their return.

Restrictions on leaving home

The Government announced the following restrictions this evening for everyone:

- You must not leave, or be outside of, your home except where necessary.
- You may leave the home to:
 - shop for necessities, for you or a vulnerable person
 - go to work, or provide voluntary or charitable services, if you cannot reasonably do so from home
 - exercise with your household (or support bubble) or one other person, this should be limited to once per day, and you should not travel outside your local area.
 - meet your support bubble or childcare bubble where necessary, but only if you are legally permitted to form one.
